



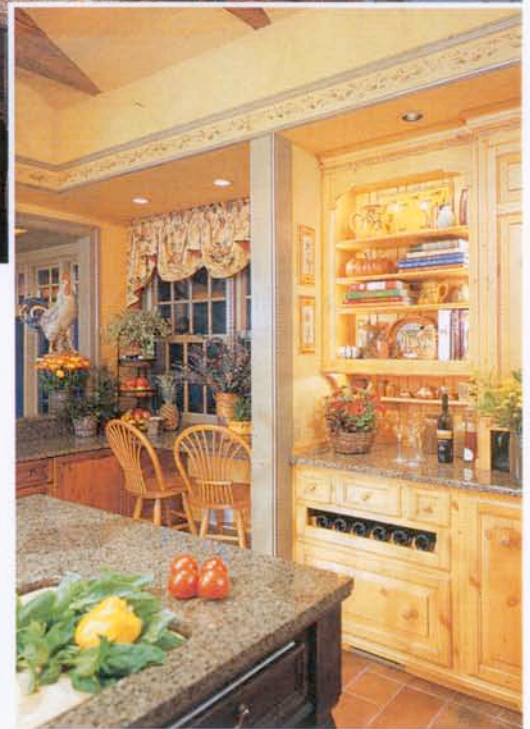
Inspired by the English Countryside, the designer uses a myriad of textures and wood styles to create a kitchen that is both warm and workable. Large triangular beams and newly milled old oak fencing were used on the ceiling

to give this space its historical dimension. The kitchen cupboard and open ceiling plan provide a wonderful venue for displaying the owner's prize collection of pottery.

**SPECIAL DESIGN FEATURES:** Existing attic space was borrowed to elevate the ceiling an additional 6 feet. The antique brick wall is original to the house and was the driving force behind many of the color and texture selections. A kitchen cupboard, adjacent to the center island, provides additional display space.
